Visiting the Campus by Car:

Parking is available in close proximity to the School of Architecture. The most convenient lot available to visitors is located on Harrison Street, just across from the Art and Architecture Building. Two parking garages are also available to visitors and are located at the intersections of Halsted and Taylor, and Racine and Harrison. From the North: Take the Kennedy Expressway (I-90/94) eastbound to the Eisenhower Expressway (I-290) westbound. Exit immediately at Morgan Street, and head south to Harrison Street. The School of Architecture is located east of Morgan Street, at the intersection of Harrison Street and Halsted Street.

From the South: Take the Dan Ryan Expressway (I-90/94) westbound to Roosevelt Road. Travel west on Roosevelt Road to Halsted Street, heading north on Halsted Street. The School of Architecture is located just west of Halsted Street on Harrison Street.

From the East: Take Harrison Street westbound to Halsted Street. The School of Architecture is located just west of Halsted Street. Or, take Roosevelt Road westbound to Halsted Street, travel north on Halsted Street to Harrison Street. The School of Architecture is located at the intersection of Halsted Street and Harrison Street.

From the West Take the Eisenhower Expressway (I-290) eastbound, exit at Racine. Travel south briefly to Harrison Street, head east on Harrison. The School of Architecture is located just west of Halsted Street, on the intersection of Halsted Street and Harrison.

Visiting via the CTA:

By train: The UIC campus is served by the CTA's two Blue Line branches, Forest Park and 54/Cermak. The School of Architecture is best reached from the UIC-Halsted stop, but may also be reached from the Racine stop.

By bus: Several bus routes serve the UIC campus. Most convenient to the School of Architecture, located on the intersection of Halsted and Harrison, are routes 60, 7, and 8. Routes 60 and 7 depart from the loop and downtown Metra train stations and ultimately proceed west along Harrison Street to the campus, while Route 8 travels north and south of the campus along Halsted Street.

Visiting via Metra:

From Ogilvie Transportation Center: Use bus route 60, heading south along Clinton Street, to the Halsted/Harrison intersection.

From the LaSalle Street Station and the Randolph Street Station: Use Blue Line trains traveling westbound from the Washington-Dearborn stop to the UIC-Halsted stop.

From Union Station: Use bus routes 60 or 7, heading south along Clinton Street, to the Halsted/Harrison intersection.

From the Van Buren Street Station: Use route 7, heading north along Michigan Avenue, to the Halsted/Harrison intersection.
